## Event Rules

### DAY 1 EVENTS

#### QUIZ - Free Thinker

- Participants will appear in Online Screening Test (OST) on the Day 1.
- Finally 5 teams will participate in the final round of the quiz on the Day 2.

#### YOUNG EDISON

##### (Science Model Exhibition)

**Rules:** Maximum 3 in a teams

- The model can be either Working or Non Working model
- The finished model is to be brought to the competition
- Each team can exhibit only one model.
- The write up of the exhibit to be placed along with it.

#### NUKKAD NATAK

Maximum team size is 8

- Clothing or actions that could be perceived as obscene, lewd, vulgar or plainly offensive are strictly prohibited
- Negative marks for exceeding the time limit
- Language can be Hindi/English. Regional touch can be given.
- No music or electronic equipments (including microphones) are allowed.
- Decision of judges will be final and non-disputable.

Duration: Max 12 minutes

#### Clash of the Titans

##### Group Discussion (Individual Event)

Group discussion is a cardinal activity in academic, business and administrative milieus. Apart from being able to communicate fluently what matters the most is the thoughts which a participant puts in his/her speech. The judges assess multiple skills during a GD.

**Rules:**

- The students will be randomly assigned to a group.
- The topics of discussion for each group will be released.
- The discussion will go on for 12 minutes.

### ROADIES

Rules for roadies

1. Maximum team size - 05 (members)
2. Complete game is divided into four stages.
  - (a) All team will participate in the first round.
  - (b) Only 7 teams will be selected for the 2<sup>nd</sup> round.
  - (c) Only 3 teams will be selected for the 3<sup>rd</sup> round.
  - (d) Only 2 teams will be selected for the final round.

### ABCD

(Any Body Can Dance)  
 Solo or Group or Five

It is a **Street Dance** competition so Choreography must be in street dance styles- commercial choreography, hip-hop, locking, popping, waacking, dancehall, krumping, house, etc.

- Any safe props allowed (no fire or pyrotechnics allowed under any circumstances);
- Backdrops, scenery are permitted provided they can be carried on, set up and removed within 60 seconds of being called for the performance.
- Each team/performer will be evaluated by the judges on the following criteria: skills, street presentation, musicality, performance, creativity.
- It is particularly important for the participants to stick with street dance styles.

### ANDROID GAME (MINI MILITIA)

Requirement: Android Mobile with minimum 1GB RAM

Rules: Maximum number of candidate in one time - 10 There will be a qualifier round by which 16 candidates will be shortlisted for next round based on score. Final winner will decide by following rounds: quarterfinal, semifinal & final round.

- Judges' decision is final

### AD MAD SHOW

#### **Rules & Regulation**

1. The Topic of Ad shall be provided before event.
2. After getting topic teams will be given 15 min for preparation
3. The maximum time for presentation of Ad is 3 minutes.
4. The Advertisement Shall be in either Hindi or English.
5. This Ad Mad is a Team event of 3 to 5 players.
6. The caution should be taken to refrain from displaying obscenity, violence, prejudice, defamation etc. in Advertisement.
7. The decision of Judges will be final and binding.

### TREASURE HUNT
